









Project Timeline







1 NE Watershed — Other Work and Pre-Treatment




Other Stormwater BMPs in Columbia Drainage Area:

- Central Ave Grit Chamber (project component)



















HABITAT ENHANCEMENT

Construction Cost:

- Bid amount of \$6,417,219 plus 15% contingency, totaling \$7,379,801
 - City of Minneapolis: \$2,908,012
 - MWMO funds (Not-to-Exceed): \$3,571,789
 - Board of Water & Soil Resources (BWSR) grant: \$800,000
 - Hennepin County grant: \$100,000
 - MPRB land










100-year Event Inundation Area (7.3 inches/24 hours)





WATER QUALITY



- Water quality treatment for 600+ acres currently untreated before entering Mississippi River
- Reduce total phosphorus loading to Mississippi River by over 170 lbs/year* (35% reduction)
 - *1 lb of phosphorus ~ 300-500 lbs algae
- Reduces total suspended solids loading to Mississippi River by over 37 tons/year






CONSTRUCTION OVERVIEW & SCHEDULE



Phase 1: October 2020 –
February 2021

- Removals/abandon storm sewer
- Storm sewer construction
- Tunnel under CP Railroad
- Earthwork and Mass Grading





CONSTRUCTION OVERVIEW & SCHEDULE





• Phase 2: May 2021 – August 2021

- Final Grading
 - Golf Course
 - **Infiltration Basin**
 - Trail
- Park Restoration
- Golf Course Restoration
- Native Seeding (Permanent Restoration)









- Hours of Operation
 - Monday through Friday 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Construction Start Date October 26, 2020
- Substantial Completion –July 2021
- 2-Year Landscape Plant Establishment & Native Vegetation Maintenance Period June 2023





TRAFFIC CONTROL & PARK IMPACTS



- Construction vehicles on Columbia Parkway and Central Avenue
- 5th Street Closure approximately 10/28 11/17/2020
- Parking lot closure for duration of project (staging area)
- Closure of trail on west side of golf course for the duration of the project
 - Pedestrians detoured to west side of 5th Street up to 35th Ave NE, bicycles use 5th Street and Columbia Parkway, full lane
- Columbia picnic shelter rental closed through July 2021
- Multi-Purpose Athletic Field closed through July 2021
- Columbia Golf Course temporary reduction from 18 holes to 11 holes through August 2021
- Tot playground equipment replacement
- Impacts to trees
 - Tree replacement in restoration plan
