### **Purpose**

The CAC meets at the request of the MWMO Board of Commissioners to assist in managing the water resources of the MWMO. The CAC fulfills legislative requirements for watershed management organizations (Minnesota Rules 8410).

## **Scope of Responsibilities**

- 1. Review funding proposals (Stewardship Fund Grants, Capital Improvement Projects, etc)
- 2. Review the MWMO's annual budget
- 3. Participate in planning for the watershed
- 4. Other, as assigned by the MWMO Board of Commissioners

# **Membership Policy**

#### All Positions

Preference is given to applicants who are:

- 1. Residents of the MWMO
- 2. Residents of a subwatershed flowing into the MWMO
- 3. An employer or employee in the MWMO
- 4. An employer or employee from a subwatershed flowing into the MWMO

## **At-Large Positions**

Up to two at-large positions may be filled by residents outside the MWMO's boundary. Diverse expertise and backgrounds are welcome (i.e., education, business, planning, etc.).
