THE MWMO is a public organization that partners to protect and improve water and habitat in an urban setting. We invest in people and infrastructure to support clean water, and provide knowledge, scientific data and expertise to help manage our vital water resources.


WHAT DOES THE MWMO DO?

The MWMO works to protect clean water and habitat by controlling pollution from urban stormwater runoff. We implement science-based solutions that capture, clean and reuse stormwater, and also conduct education and outreach to help others keep the watershed clean. Our monitoring team collects and tracks water quality data.

WHAT DO INTERNS DO?

MWMO interns work with staff and partner organizations to protect water quality in the Mississippi River and beyond. Interns assist with monitoring activities, field work, data analysis, education and outreach and other activities as needed.

Interns generally work 20-40 hours per week.



OUR BOUNDARIES

The boundaries of the MWMO contain two small lakes and a 14-mile stretch of the Mississippi River as it travels through the Twin Cities metropolitan area.
