PROJECT: CHILDREN'S DENTAL SERVICES

Over three years, the project team utilized all three types of Stewardship Fund grants to improve stormwater management and engage visitors around clean water efforts at their Hennepin Avenue office. A Community Grant funded soil testing and analysis, a Planning Grant funded the design of a new permeable pavement parking lot, and an Action Grant helped fund the actual construction.

THE MWMO is a local unit of government whose purpose is to protect and improve water quality, habitat and natural resources inside its watershed boundaries.


STEWARDSHIP FUND GRANTS

MWMO Stewardship Fund Grants are available for a wide range of projects to protect and improve water quality, habitat, and natural resources in our urban watershed.

From raingardens to neighborhood cleanup events to innovative stormwater features, visit mwm.org/projects for past project examples.

PROJECT CRITERIA

1. Develop partnerships with community organizations
2. Protect or improve the quality of water, habitat or natural resources
3. Build community understanding, knowledge and initiative related to water, habitat and natural resource issues and solutions



GRANT TYPES

Community Grants

This grant type is for short-term or small-scale water quality projects. Up to \$5,000. No matching funds are required.

Planning Grants

This grant type is for planning a stewardship project significant in scope and cost. Up to \$20,000. The planning products (e.g. site investigations, design plans, and cost estimates) may be used for implementing future Action Grant projects. A 25% match is required.

Action Grants

This grant type is for assistance in completing a stewardship project, significant in scope and cost. Up to \$50,000. A 25% match is required.

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Recognized nonprofits
- Schools
- Officially recognized neighborhood groups
- Local units of government
- Business and professional associations
- Faith-based organizations
- Others may partner with eligible applicants (see website for details)

**Applicants may not serve a dual role as project manager and project consultant.*
